Having a say in how Derwent Valley BRIDGE is run.

The DV BRIDGE is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation. This confirms our legal status as a Registered Charity (Charity Number 1152276). As a Registered Charity we have a Constitution that says what type of organisation we are. The BRIDGE is a membership organisation. This means that members vote and appoint Trustees to manage the organisation on their behalf.

Support Derwent Valley BRIDGE by becoming a voting member. It's free.

This will entitle you to vote at the AGM and thereby influence the direction and future development of the organisation. We want to listen to the views of volunteers, library users and local residents and incorporate them into our plans.

Voting Members are entitled to nominate another voting member to be a Trustee, or stand for nomination themselves. All potential Trustees must be voting members of the organisation before they can be nominated and elected at an AGM.

In the event of the organisation being wound up, members may be required to contribute £1 to the assets of the organisation.

Being a voting member is not the same as being a NYCC library card holder.

We cannot function without voting members so please fill in the membership form below and return to us at the Library.

The Annual General Meeting is at 7pm on Thursday 30 July 2026 in the Library. You may be required to vote to elect additional Trustees who will be responsible for running DVB for the next 12 months.
